Rules	<p>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet. Clubs wishing to be invited need to contact the meet manager.</p> <p>A contestant may participate in only his or her own age group events</p> <p><b><u>Contestants may enter THREE (3) events per day.</u></b></p> <p>Swimmers shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. Entries in longer distance events may need to be limited due to time constraints. If necessary, it will be done based on the verifiable proof of entry time.</p> <p>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS equipment the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</p> <p>The practice of deck changing is prohibited at all PVS Sanctioned events. Swimmers participating in deck changing would be violating the USA Swimming Sportsmanship policy.</p> <p><b><u>Meet Manager reserves the right to Positive Check-In all 200 yard events in the interest of manageable time lines.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Meet Manager also reserves the right to adjust warm-up times for the all sessions after entries have come in.</u></b></p> <p>The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for 12 &amp; U sessions in Rule</p>

Inclusion Policy for Swimmers with a Disability	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
Time Trials	There will be no time trials conducted at this meet.
Supervision	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their Swimmers and Families and for cleaning up their team areas.  Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.  Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials are permitted on the pool deck. Working Coaches & deck officials are required to display their 2010 or 2011 USA Swimming card.  Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck.
Admission	There is no admission charge.
Programs	<b>Meet programs will be available for \$2.00 per session.</b>
Awards	There will be NO awards for this meet.
Seating	Due to the limited pool deck space, Officials, USA Swimming Registered Coaches and Swimmers only will be permitted on the pool deck.  <b>Personal Chairs <u>will BE permitted on the deck for coaches only</u>.</b>  <b>Swimmers will not be permitted to bring chairs on deck.</b>
Warning	Any club or individual that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered swimmer to represent them, will be fined by PVS the sum of \$100.00 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine has been paid.

If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the meet director.  Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
