ELIGIBILITY	<p>Open to all USA Swimming registered swimmers from PVS clubs.</p>
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<p>PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.</p>
TIMING SYSTEM	<p>Semi-Automatic Timing System will be used.</p>

RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. • No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted. • In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. • Deck changes are prohibited. • Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. • Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. • No Dive-over starts will be used at this meet. • The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	<p>Individual Events: Swimmers may participate in only his or her own age group events. <u>Swimmers may enter FOUR (4) events.</u></p> <p>To the extent there are available lanes, swimmers can request deck entry at a cost of \$15.00.</p> <p>*NOTE: The Meet Director reserves the right to rearrange sessions/ start times in order to allow the full meet to fit within the pool rental time.</p>
POSITIVE CHECK IN	<p>All Events will be pre-seeded.</p>
WARM-UP	<p>The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.</p>
SUPERVISION	<p>Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and families and for cleaning up their team areas.</p>
AWARDS	<p>Medals will be given for places 1st- 6th and 1st- 3rd for relays.</p>
PROGRAMS	<p>Programs will be available for purchase for \$3.00 or via meet mobile.</p>
CREDENTIALS	<p>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.</p>
OFFICIALS	<p>Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee, Starter, Chief Judge or Stoke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.</p> <p>Officials wishing to volunteer to work the meet should contact Machine Aquatics Head Official, Courtney Johnston, at officials@machineaquatics.com .</p>

	Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.								
TIMERS	All timers will be provided by all participating teams. Parents should use the signup link to sign up to time/ volunteer.								
CONCESSIONS	There will no concessions at this meet.								
SEATING	Due to the limited pool deck space, officials, USA Swimming registered coaches and swimmers only will be permitted on the pool deck. Personal chairs <u>will be permitted</u> on the deck for coaches only. Swimmers MAY NOT bring personal chairs on the deck.
