COVID-19 **PROTOCOLS**

- Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use will be for emergency use only and must be sanitized after each use. Family bathroom will be reserved for coach, official, and volunteer use.
- All attendees (swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers) must bring their own water bottle and snacks. Hospitality will not be provided.
- All attendees will enter and exit the facility through the patio doors. From the parking lot, attendees will walk down the access road located to the right of the main entrance and proceed through the gate where the Health Attestation and touchless temperature screenings will be completed. Per CDC guidelines, individuals with a body temperature greater than 100.4 degrees will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers) must wear masks to enter the facility and at all times when inside the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up/cooling down.
- Athletes will bring a plastic zipper bag with their name on it in which to place their masks when they are in the water.
- All attendees will be required to complete and submit a health attestation no more than four hours prior to entering the facility.

- Any attendee failing or refusing to comply with any of these Protocols will be prohibited from entering the facility and/or asked to leave the facility.
- The meet will be limited to a maximum of 80 swimmers.
- Athletes will be assigned a social distanced spot (marked with a tape X) in the bleachers or in the facility multi-purpose rooms for the duration of the meet to ensure proper 10' social distancing. Swimmers will remain in their assigned spot except while participating in warm ups and

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	competition. Swimmers may not enter another swimmer's designated area.		
	 A Clerk of Course will be used to maintain social distance and organize each heat of swimmers for all events offered. 		
	 No spectators will be permitted. Competition will be live-streamed. Details will be sent to participating families and posted on the <u>York Swim Club website</u> by Friday, November 6, 2020. 		
	 We request that all attendees notify the meet director as quickly as possible should they test positive for COVID-19, show symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed or tested positive for COVID-19 after attending the meet. 		
RULES	 Current USA Swimming rules, including the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u> ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet. 		
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.		
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.		
	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 		
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. 		
	Dive-over starts will not be used at this meet.		
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
	No deck entries will be accepted.		
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.		
	All events are 13 & Over and mixed gender.		
	Swimmers may enter up to three (3) events.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.		
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.		
	 Warm Ups will have two 20 minute sessions. Each session will consist of no more than 40 swimmers total, no more than four (4) swimmers per lane. Swimmers will be assigned a warm up session. 		
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.		
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded.		
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.		
AWARDS	No awards will be given at this meet.		
PROGRAMS	 Programs will be emailed out to participating families by Friday, November 6, 2020. 		

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CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times. 		
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	This meet will have no spectators.		
	• This meet will be live-streamed. Details will be sent to participating families and posted on the York Swim Club website by Friday, November 6, 2020.		
OFFICIALS	 Officials will be identified in advance and coordinated by the York Officials Chair, Carolyn Kotarski, <u>ckotarski@gmail.com</u>. Officials interested in volunteering should contact the Officials Chair. 		
	• Officials who have volunteered for this meet should check in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials working this meet will need to wear a mask for the duration of the meet. A comprehensive official's briefing will be conducted online on Friday, November 6, 2020.		
	Walk-on officials cannot be accommodated.		
TIMERS	One timer per lane. Lane assignments will be made in advance. All timers are required to wear a mask while timing.		
ENTRY PROCEDURES	 Entries will be managed by the Meet Director, Kristin Bryant Wolff, <u>kristin@yorkswim.com</u>. Entries will be submitted through the York Swim Club entry system. 		
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
