

	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	• This meet has no qualifying times. Short course times are conforming.
	• Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.
	An athlete may only compete in his or her own age division.
	• A contestant may enter no more than four (4) individual events per day.
	Entries limited to 1st 4500 received.
	• Each session is limited to 350 athletes. Once capacity has been reached, no more entries will be accepted.
	• Deck entries will be accepted however no new heats will be created. The fee is \$15.00 per individual event.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• Events may require positive check-in. If so, check-in closing times will be 30 minutes before the start of the session for the first 3 strokes and the remaining events will close 90 minutes after the start of the first event of the session.

WARM-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.

FACILITY RULES	Swimmers are not to leave the pool deck without appropriate attire.
	No glass containers are permitted within the pool area.

PROGRAMS	Meet Programs will be posted to Meet Mobile and emailed to participating teams.

CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming
	membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	There is no admission charge.
	 Spectator capacity is limited to 250 people in the gallery.
	No chairs may be set up in the lobby.
	There will be no concessions.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	• Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	• Officials interested in volunteering should contact Linda Tucker (<u>lastucker@verizon.net</u>) by April 30, 2023.
	• Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	• Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.
	• The Meet Director will determine the number of timers per club and lane assignments.
	Volunteers may sign up on the volunteer link.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	• Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director (<u>fairlandswim@comcast.net</u>).
	• Include in the subject of the email, Early Bird 2023 - **** with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	• Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
