

### **RULES** Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warmup, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Dive-over starts will be used. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. **EVENT RULES** Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. Athletes may only compete in events of his/her own age group. All athletes may enter a maximum of 3 events per day, not exceeding 6 total entries. For Session #1, swimmers that quality in the top 16 in the 13-14 and 15 & Over 100 Breaststroke and the 13-14 and 15 and Over 100 Freestyle will be eligible to race in "Super Finals." "Super Finals" will take place at the conclusion of Session 1. For Session #4, swimmers that qualify in the top 16 in the 13-14 and 15 & Over 100 Backstroke as well as the 13-14 and 15 & Over 50 Freestyle will be eligible to race in "Super Finals." "Super Finals." will take place at the conclusion of Session 4. "Super Final" events in Session 1 and 4 will have two (2) heats in the Finals Session, "B" final and "A" final. The "B" final will swim first, followed by the "A" final. The B Final will be 8 swimmers seeded #9 through #16 in prelims with swimmers seeded #1-8 racing in the A Finals. All other events in Session #1 and #4 will be timed finals. All events in Sessions #2, 3, 5 and #6 will be timed finals. All swimmers are permitted to participate in only one session per day. Deck entries will be accepted in empty lanes only. No new heats will be created. Proof of USA Swimming membership required for athletes not previously entered in the meet. **POSITIVE CHECK-IN** The Meet Director will identify events requiring positive check-in after entries are received. Events determined to require positive check-in and positive check-in schedule will be communicated to attending clubs.

WITHDRAWING FROM FINALS	• Swimmers who do not wish to swim in the Final must "Scratch" from the event by completing the Scratch from Finals form within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers for the A and B Finals.
	• Swimmers may declare an "Intent to Scratch" by completing the Scratch from Finals form within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers for the A and B finals, indicating Intent. Intents to Scratch must be confirmed within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the swimmer's last preliminary event of the session or they will be automatically seeded into Finals.
	• If a swimmer fails to properly scratch from an event and does not appear for the Final event, they shall be removed from their next scheduled individual event.

	Coaches should make sure their contact information is up to date. The coach or team representative will be contacted should a swimmer scratch into finals

WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	Five lanes of continuous warm up will be available.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
	Spectators are not allowed on the pool deck.
	Swimmers may not bring personal chairs on the pool deck.

SEEDING	Standard seeding will be used.

AWARDS	All swimmers will receive a Forty Niner commemorative bag tag.
	All heat winners will receive a Western Duck.
PROGRAMS	Meet programs will not be sold. The meet will be available on Meet Mobile.
CREDENTIALS	• Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should always have proof of active USA Swimming membership on hand.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee, Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	• Officials interested in volunteering should complete the <u>Officials Signup</u> or contact the Meet Referee, Tim Husson ( <u>tim.husson@gmail.com</u> ).
	• Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-up.
TIMERS	Two timers per lane.
	• Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.
	A Sign-Up Genius will be provided two weeks prior to the meet.
	<ul> <li>All Timers are required to wear their timer lanyard, signaling their access to the deck.</li> </ul>
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ENTRY	Entries should be submitted by email to <u>fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com</u>		
PROCEDURES	Include in the subject of the email, "FXFX Forty Niner - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include the training site in the subject line.		
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director ( <a href="mailto:fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com">fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com</a> ).		
	<ul> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.</li> </ul>
