## Swimwear used at Competitions Did you know?

USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1C states....

Only swimsuits complying with FINA Swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition.

FINA Requirements for Swimwear Approval states...

No zippers or other fastening system allowed.

What does this mean for your swimmers?

The popular swimsuits that many of our female athletes wear that are tied in the back are not permitted to be wore during competition. They can be worn at practice or during meet warm-ups.

#### **PVS Coaches Continuing Education Grant**

PVS offers six continuing education grants to coaches in PVS each year.

Each grant is for \$500 and is awarded based on a lottery of grant applications submitted.

Submission of grant applications ends on June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year and the lottery is to be held at LC Senior Champs. The 2016 PVS Coaches Continuing Education Grant Application (updated) will be available on the PVS website after the January meeting of the Competition Committee.

PVS Coaches who serve as the PVS SC Zone Head Coach and PVS SC Zone Assistant Head Coach are guaranteed one of the six continuing education grants in the year in which they serve in that position. The coach need only submit a grant application before the deadline in order to receive the grant. (Per PVS Policy and Procedures)
