USA Swimming Rule Change – Medley Swimming

Try It: Sharing an Idea (From One Coach to Another)

Bird and Bait From: JoAnn Catania, Monroe Woodbury Devilfish

- Equipment Needed: None
- Purpose: To Encourage Team Building and Fast Swimming
- Stroke: Coaches Choice
- First, break swimmers into pairs of close ability.
- Second, Explain the rules:
 - o All swimmers are on the deck and cheering for their teammates.
 - One person is chosen to be the "Bird" and One person is chosen to be the "Bait" in each lane.
 - o The "Bait" hops in the water, holds 1 hand on the wall, for an in the water start.
 - The "Bird" hops up on the starting block or is at the pool edge and awaits coach's directions, for when to safely enter the water (Forward start)
- The idea is: The Bird must try catch the Bait and the Bait must try to outswim the Bird.
- The coach must be clear that No one leaves the block with specific instructions. (Safety first)
- Third, When Bird and Bait are in place:
 - The coach shouts "Bait GO!" 0 the swimmer at the wall leaves and swims as fast as they can to reach the opposite wall.
 - When the Bait passes the starting end flags, the coach shouts "Bird GO!"
- The kids never want it to end and switch lanes and partners to challenge each other.

PVS: Long Course Championship Meets Format Proposal

A proposal was brought before the PVS Competition Committee at the September 2017 meeting for changes to the PVS Long Course Championship Meets by Mark Faherty, Senior Chair. A vote is planned for an the January Competition Committee Meeting.

Proposal:

- 1. PVS LC Senior Championships (2nd Weekend in July, where it is currently placed)
 - No changes to this meet
- 2. PVS LC 12&Under Age Group Championships (2nd Weekend in July)
 - a. Qualifying times for 11-12 age group and 9-10 age group
 - b. Current Format (Thurs, Fri, Sun Prelims/Finals, Saturday Timed Finals Distance)
 - c. Two separate Prelims sessions: 11-12 and 9-10
 - d. Facility: A location other than UMD as Senior Champs would be at UMD
- 3. PVS LC Junior Championships (3rd Weekend in July)
 - a. 13-14 age group: Qualifying Times
 - b. 15-18 age group: Qualifying Times plus No Faster Than Times (Senior Champs)
 - c. Format the same as PVS LC 12&Under Age Group Champs
 - d. Facility: UMD

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
