



## Scholastic All-American Recognition

The mission of the Disability Swimming Committee is the full inclusion of swimmers with a disability in USA Swimming programs

---

Swimmers with disabilities are eligible for Scholastic All-American Team recognition. Criteria include:

- Must have completed 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- Must be a USA Swimming member athlete
- Must have competed in an individual event in specified elite-level disability swimming competitions (named in the application form)
- Must have achieved a 3.5 GPA



Certificates and awards are mailed to each Scholastic All-American in late fall. Applications are posted on the applications/forms section of the USA Swimming web site in January of each year. The deadline for submission (typically mid-late summer) is included on the application form.

The Scholastic All American program is administered by the SAA Sub-Committee of the Times and Recognition Committee. The program was begun in 1986 and has been staffed by dedicated USA Swimming volunteers from across the country for the past 22 years.
