Equipment

- Equipment Manager, Carrie Tupper, has done a very good job managing and maintaining the PVS equipment.
- New equipment procured in the last year includes a timing console, two starting systems, and misc. cables and support parts.
- Several of the PVS timing consoles and many of the PVS starting units were repaired this year.
- PVS now has enough working equipment to support a short course four-meet weekend (i.e. November Open) or a long course two-meet weekend (i.e PVS LC Open).
- PVS purchased a new timing system from [Superior Swim Timing](#). It consists of a small interface box and software that runs on a laptop computer. It is much less expensive than our current timing consoles. I have tested it at one PVS meet this season and am looking for opportunities to test it at some more meets.
- Fairland Aquatics Center and the Prince George's Sports and Learning Complex bought new timing equipment and large scoreboards. This may cut down on the number of rentals of PVS equipment in the future.
