EXPERIENCE

My swimming career started at the age of 5 with the Elyria YMCA/USS Swim Club in the Lake Erie LSC. My love of swimming was further fueled by helping younger athletes on my team when I was I 4yrs old. I started my USA Swimming coaching career in the Georgia LSC with the West Georgia Swim Club in 2005. In 2009, I moved to NOVA and started coaching with the Blue Waves Swim Team. In addition to BWST, I have coached with Lifetime Fitness (LIFE) and HACC in Potomac Valley. Currently, I am coaching with Machine Aquatics at their Audrey Moore, Tyson's Sport and Health, and Tuckahoe locations. This season, I am the Assistant Coach for the Senior Orange and Senior Silver Groups, Age Group Coach at Audrey Moore, Coach for the Late Night Age Group and Senior Silver practice at Tyson's Sport & Health, and Assistant Coach for the Tuckahoe Stroke Mechanics Group. In addition to my coaching, I teach Private Lessons, Semi-private Lessons, Group Lessons, and Competitive Private Lessons (Video Analysis) at the Machine Performance Center.

I have served as a PVS Zone Coach for two short course and three long course trips and the PVS Zone Team Manager for two short course and one long course trips. Currently, I am completing my fourth year as one of the Coaches Representative to the PVS Board of Directors. Also, I volunteer my time as an official for PVS. I am a N2 Stroke & Turn Official and a Hy-tek Computer Operator. As of the middle of April 2018, I am working to complete my Electronic Timing System (ETS) Operator certification with plans to obtain my Administrative Official (AO) certification.

In my time serving as one of the Coaches Representatives to the PVS Board of Directors, I have tried to be a voice for all coaches no matter the club or the level of swimmers that they work with.
