

4.4 DUTIES AND POWERS - The House of Delegates shall oversee the management of the affairs of PVS and the establishment of policies, procedures and programs. In addition to the duties and powers prescribed in the USA-S Code or elsewhere in these Bylaws, the House of Delegates may:

.4 Ratify or prospectively modify or rescind policy and program established by the Board of Directors, except any action or authorization by the Board of Directors with respect to contracts or upon which any person may have relied shall not be modified or rescinded;

.7 Amend the Bylaws of PVS in accordance with Section 11.3; and

11.3 AMENDMENTS - Any provision of these Bylaws not mandated by USA-S may be amended at any meeting of the House of Delegates by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting. Amendments so approved shall not take effect until reviewed and approved by the USA-S Legislation Sub-committee.

PROPOSAL # 1

A member club in good standing shall be defined as follows,

- a) No financial obligation shall be older than 90 days.
- b) Attendance at 2 out 4 annual LSC meetings.
- c) Maintain accurate, up to date records of coaches and officials.
- d) Maintain 2 or more certified officials.

The above four points can also be presented as individual proposals if necessary. Friendly amendments are welcome.

PROPOSAL # 2

Club registration dues should be raised to \$ 500 per year, of which a credit of \$ 400 will be given to clubs who are in compliance with the above proposal should it pass.

PROPOSAL # 3

Group Members should be split into two groups. Active and Inactive {or whatever name is Politically Correct! ☺} An Active member club will be one defined as competing in 10 or more meets sanctioned within the LSC each year.

Based on the above, quorum would be 31 rather than 40, based on the list of delegates below.
