Below are some housekeeping items for the coaches/parents for the upcoming meet. Please make sure all the coaches receive the following information.

George Mason University Meet Reminders:

- No parents will be allowed through the swimmers entrance, in the locker rooms, or on to the pool deck.
 - If parents/guardians have concerns about their children entering the facility on their own, the coaching staff for the child's team needs to be responsible for shuttling their young athletes from the entrance to the pool area.
 - If a parent/guardian wants to dress their child at the facility then the child and parent/guardian must enter the front doors of the AFC and change their child in the upstairs rest rooms. The child and parent/guardian will then need to exit the facility and take the child to re-enter at the swimmers entrance on the lower southwest side of the building. Parents/guardians must still access the facility through the front doors. If a parent is concerned about their child changing without them we encourage them to have their child already dressed upon arrival.
- As parents/guardians will not be allowed on the deck we want to encourage families to set up meeting places and times to reunite after the events or meet ends to assist in avoiding any lost child scares. Even with the technology of cell phones, it is always good to have a back up plan.
- No personal chairs on deck or in the facility.
- No food allowed on deck.
- Please park in Lot C
 - Saturday evening the back portion of lot C will be closed off for a motor cycle class that will take place on Sunday. Be aware and respect George Mason Parking lot sign information.
- If Lot C is full, you may park in Lot A.
- If dropping off/picking up you may utilize the drop off/pick up route in the front of Lot C. This is where your swimmers will enter and exit the facility.
- Do NOT drop off or pick up at the front of the facility.
- No one will be permitted to enter the facility prior to the posted time in the meet announcement.
