Eligibility:	Open to all Potomac Valley Swimmers Registered as USA Swimming Athletes ages 8 & Under who are Registered USA Swimming Athletes. All athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.		
Inclusion Policy for Swimmers with a Disability:	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.		

Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet. All events are timed finals. All events will be swum slowest to fastest. A contestant may enter no more than three (3) individual events per day. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of Rules: swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. (this statement can either be under RULES or SUPERVISION). The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. Warm-up and Saturday Session Warm-up 12:45-1:15 pm, 1st Event 1:25 p m Meet Sunday Session Warm-up 12:45-1:15 pm, 1st Event 1:25 p m Schedule: The prescribed Potomac Valley Swimming Warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of Warm-up: the warm-up, including times and lane assignments. **Public** There is no public admission charge. Programs for each session will be Admission and available for \$2.00 **Program Fee:** Individual events will be awarded first through eighth place. Relay events will be awarded for first place through third place. A heat award will be given to Awards: the winner of each individual heat. Entry Fees:

Each club is requested to remit one check, payable to **Potomac Marlins**, to cover the entry fees for the entire team. Please do not send cash. Meet Directors have been instructed not to accept telephone entries. **No late entries for individual or relay events will be accepted.**

Deadline:	The Meet Director must receive all entries and check for this meet no later than 5:00 pm. Tuesday, January 14, 2014. Important: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers.
