FACILITY	<p style="text-align: center;">Burke Racquet & Swim Club 6001 Burke Commons Road Burke, Virginia (703-250-1299)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The pool at the Burke Racquet and Swim club is 25m x 25yd pool, with 12 available 25 yd lanes. Competition will be held in 4 lanes, 25 yards. Water depth range of 4' 5" – 5' at the starting end and 4' 5" – 4' 6" at the turning end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 104.2.2(C).

Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.</p>

ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open to USA Swimming-registered NCAP-Burke swimmers. No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules & Regulations</i> Article 302.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.

<p>COVID-19 PROTOCOLS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions, to include temperature screening. • Please consult the Facility Map for all COVID-19 logistics participants must adhere to. • Athletes must arrive in their RACING suits. Locker rooms will remain closed. Swimmers will remain in their cars in the parking lot when not in the pool for warm-ups or competition. • All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, spectators) must wear a mask to enter the facility and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up/cooling down. • Swimmers will be pre-seeded and staged by heat assignment at the front entrance utilizing Socially Distance markings before entry and inside prior to each swim. These locations will be monitored with the flow of traffic heading towards the 4 competitive lanes from the swimmer/official entrance. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1 location on Pool deck along Lane 1 ○ The deck will have a queue of 3 heats waiting to race on pool deck socially distanced • Once each heat has finished swimming, swimmers will snake a 50 to 100 loosen up and retrieve their bag and mask prior to exiting the rear indicated location of the pool. • Athletes and families are to remain outside the pool and must maintain proper social distancing. Participants and family members not adhering to this standard will be asked to leave the premises immediately. Participants asked to leave will not be allowed to race.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be no spectator seating. There will an outside “watch & go” section through the pool window along Lane 1 outside of the facility. One spectator PER SWIMMER will be allowed to the “watch & go” area while masked. • Restroom facilities are for EMERGENCY USE ONLY for all. Restroom access will also be controlled. Disinfecting products will be available at the doors and must be used on any touched surface by each user.
RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), shall govern this meet. • No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted. • In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. • Deck changes are prohibited. • Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. • Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. • Dive-over starts will not be used at this meet. • The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. • No deck entries will be accepted.
EVENT RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events are timed finals. • Swimmers may enter no more than four (4) events.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events will be pre-seeded.
WARM-UP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments. During warm-ups, four (4) swimmers will be allowed per lane.
SUPERVISION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Events will be seeded slow to fast.
SCORING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will not be scored.
AWARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are no awards for this meet.
PROGRAMS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet programs, including an estimated timeline for reporting to the clerk of course will be emailed to participating families.
CREDENTIALS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not

	permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.

A comprehensive officials briefing will be conducted 3-4 hours before scheduled warm-ups via Zoom.
