Jeff Rouse Swim and Sport Center Supplemental Document/Information

In applying for this sanction, the Host, Nation's Capital Swim Club, agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, Virginia Swimming Inc, the Commonwealth of Virginia, Stafford County County, and Jeff Rouse Center.

Local Protocols and Requirements

All facility, local, and state protocols and <u>USA Swimming COVID-19 guidance</u> will be followed. This includes:

- All individuals aged two and older are encouraged to cover their mouth and nose with a mask
 in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidance linked here.
- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use should be minimized (i.e., emergencies only and no showering will be allowed).
- No one may enter the facility if they have a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing.
- No one may enter the facility if they are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or if they have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

Safe Sport Considerations

In compliance with Safe Sport, parents will have access to and the opportunity to observe their child, either through spectator seating and/or a livestream.

Meet Specific COVID-19 Protocols

- No one with symptoms of COVID-19 will be permitted in the facility.
- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use should be minimized. Specific bathrooms will be available for coach/official/volunteer/spectator use.
- All attendees (swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers) must bring their own water bottle and snacks. Limited hospitality may be provided.
- A Clerk of Course may be utilized for some sessions and/or specific events.
- Attendees will enter the facility through the side doors. Swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers will exit the facility through the side door by the splash pool. Spectators will enter and exit the facility using the main doors.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators) are encouraged to wear masks to enter the facility and at all times when inside the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up.
- The meet will be limited to a maximum of 600 swimmers per session.
- Spectators will be permitted.
 - o No personal chairs are allowed in the spectator area or in the lobby.
 - No one is permitted to stand in the aisle. Spectators must be seated.
 - Seating may be limited.
 - Please be considerate of others wishing to view their swimmer's races. Please exit the spectator area to allow for others to be seated.
- We request that all attendees notify the meet director as quickly as possible should they test positive for COVID-19, show symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed or tested positive for COVID-19 after attending the meet.
- Any attendee failing or refusing to comply with any of these protocols will be prohibited from entering the facility and/or asked to leave the facility.
