ELIGIBILITY	<ul> <li>Open to USA Swimming registered swimmers from invited USA Swimming clubs. Clubs wishing to receive an invitation to attend should contact the Meet Director, Matt Salerno (fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com).</li> </ul>
	• No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules &amp; Regulations</i> Article 302.
	All athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <a href="Inclusion Policy">Inclusion Policy</a> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	<ul> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts may be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	<ul> <li>All events in Sessions 1 and 4 will follow a prelims/finals format except for the 200 Breaststroke, 400 IM, 200 Butterfly, and 400 Freestyle. There will be three heats swum at finals for each Preliminary event. Heats will be swum in the following order: C, B, A.</li> </ul>
	Events will be seeded using LCM times. Athletes who do not have LCM entry times will be seeded with NT.
	• All swimmers must provide their own timer for the 400m IM and 400m Free and all events taking place on Saturday, June 24, 2023.
	Athletes participating in Session 4 may swim a maximum of two events/session.
	• Swimmers 13 & over may enter and compete in up to three (3) events each day, with a maximum of seven (7) events for the meet.
	• Swimmers 12 & under may enter and compete in up to four (4) events each day, with a maximum of nine (9) events for the meet.
	<ul> <li>Swimmers aged 12 &amp; under may only enter one (1) session per day.</li> <li>Deck entries will be accepted on a limited basis. No new heats will be created to accommodate a deck-entered swimmer.</li> </ul>

POSITIVE CHECK-IN	All events 400m and longer will be positive check-in.
WITHDRAWING FROM	• If swimmers do not want to swim in the Final race(s), they may "scratch" from the event by
FINALS	following this procedure:  o Email <a href="mailto:scratchfxfx@gmail.com">scratchfxfx@gmail.com</a> within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers for the event.
	<ul> <li>Email must include swimmer's first and last name, club, coach's name, and event being scratched. It is recommended that you include your coach in the email.</li> </ul>
	Coaches should make sure their contact information is up-to-date. The meet director will contact the coach or team representative should a swimmer scratch into finals.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
	Spectators are not allowed on the pool deck; swimmers may not bring personal chairs on the pool deck; coaches may bring a personal chair on the pool deck.
SEEDING	All events 200m and shorter will be pre-seeded at 6:00pm the evening prior to the session.  Swimmers unable to participate should contact the meet director.
	Open 800m Freestyle, 1500m Freestyle, and 12&U 400m Freestyle on Saturday will be swum fastest to slowest.
SCORING	The meet will not be scored.
AWARDS	All swimmers will receive a commemorative Summer Solstice bag tag (that they will need for entry on deck at St. James).
PROGRAMS	Meet programs and results will be available on Meet Mobile.
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer, or other position are not permitted on deck or in the facility before, during, or after the meet.
	Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, deck officials and volunteers will be permitted on deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
	Athletes will need to present their Summer Solstice bag tag for entry to the pool deck.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
OFFICIALS	Officials will be identified in advance and coordinated by the Meet Referee, Tim Husson     (tim.husson@gmail.com). Officials interested in volunteering should complete the Online Signup or email the Meet Referee.
	A comprehensive official's briefing will be conducted prior to each session.
TIMERS	Two (2) timers per lane.
	Each club will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of entries. The Meet     Director will assign timer requirements to each club after entries have been received. The Meet     Director will notify clubs of their timer requirements by email. each.
	Lane assignments will be made in advance.
	Timers should report to the timers meeting 20 minutes before the start of the session.

ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director, fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com.		
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2023 FXFX LC Summer Solstice - XXXX" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files, include the training site in the subject of the email.		
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	• In the body of your email, provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.		
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.		
	<ul> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 per occurrence by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the fine is paid.</li> </ul>		
ENTRY FEES	Per swimmer surcharge: \$5.00 Individual event fee: \$15.00 Deck Entry: \$20.00
