	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted		
	<ul> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> </ul>		
	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>		
	Dive-over starts will not be used at this meet.		
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All Relays must check in before the end of warm up for each Saturday session. Relay slips will be distributed to the coaches for check in.		
	Relays will be seeded in every other lane.		
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will assign times and lane assignments for the warm up.		
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.		
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.		
SEEDING	All individual events will be pre-seeded. Relays will be seeded after check in.		
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.		
AWARDS	Individual events will be awarded first through tenth place. Relay events will be awarded for first place through fourth place. A heat award will be given to the winner of each individual heat.		

PROGRAMS	Meet programs will be available for spectators at each session for \$2.00			
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.			
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	There will be no spectator entry fee.			
OFFICIALS	Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stoke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.

	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted			
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted			
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
