Competition will be held in 8 lanes, 25 yards, running from wall to wall. Continuous warm-up/cool- down will be available. Water depth ranges from 5' – 13' at both the start and turn ends. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition. 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	Deck entries will be accepted if the meet is not over-subscribed. Swimmers will be entered into open lanes in existing heats on a first come, first served basis. No new heats will be created. All deck entries must be submitted no later than 45 minutes prior to first event of each session.

POSITIVE CHECK	• There will be positive check in for events 400M and longer. The check in will be due 30 minutes before the start of events. The Meet Director will determine if additional events will require positive check in		
	• Athletes who check into a positive check-in event, have been seeded and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next scheduled individual event, unless excused by the Meet Referee.		
WARM-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments based upon the number of swimmers per session to accommodate the appropriate number of swimmers per lane.		
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.

	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	 The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
