1. New Club Application—Dream Sharks, Head Coach Jae Hyuk Yang. Training site—Oak Marr, Tuesday evening; Saturday morning; Saturday, Sunday evenings. Application has been cleared by the PVS Membership Chair and is pending with USA Swimming. Recommended approval following USA Swimming approval. Electronic vote expected between January and February 2010 meetings consistent with past practice. Note that once cleared by USA Swimming this application cannot be denied without a showing of cause.

Note that athlete numbers are down (slightly) for the first time in many years. This was anticipated-- including in the current budget planning. The non-athlete numbers are substantially higher though.

3. Fines on Clubs without sufficient certified officials.

This is a real success story of the LSC—for the 2006-2007 season there were about a dozen clubs with potential fines and 3 ended up being required to pay under the policy. For 2007-2008 the number dropped significantly for potential fines and one was required to pay. For 2008-2009 only one club had a potential fine and their 12/31/09 numbers justified waiver of any fine. The increase in non-athlete registered persons (above) reflects a great effort of the coaches and clubs and presumably can be tied to this policy and a general emphasis on increasing the base of certified officials.
