The PVS Diversity Committee opens the meet to all PVS registered athletes. We have 100 spots available. This joint trip will allow for those swimmers in the LSC to compete as a travel team representing various PVS as one unit at the meet. The goal is to promote unity, friendship and good competition for the athletes of PVS.

The Triangle Aquatic Center (TAC) facility features a 50 meter competition pool divided into two courses, which include an 8-lane, 25-yard by 9-feet wide competition course and a 10-lane, 25-yard by 7-feet, 6 inches-wide competition course, with a variable depth ranging from 7 to 12 feet. Both courses will be used if swimmer numbers and timeline deem it necessary. An additional 10-lane 25-yard pool is available for continuous warm up/warm down. The facility is 72,000 sq. feet and has comfortable spectator seating capacity for 1000 people. The TAC facility has a full-service café and an All-American Swim Shop on site. The TAC facility is conveniently located off Interstate 40 at Exit 291 and is adjacent to Cary's largest shopping mall, Cary Towne Center.

## Participants

In order for participants to be able to participate in the meet, they will need to be registered PVS athletes, fill out an application (much like the zone team), sign the PVS code of conduct, provide funding for the trip, and entry form. Ages of the swimmers traveling will vary from 10-18 years old.
