I would like to recognize and congratulate our newest Safe Sport Recognized club, Tollefson Swimming. We now have 20 PVS clubs that have achieved the recognition. We are approaching my goal of half of the non-college PVS clubs completing this process. I know other PVS clubs are still working on the certification process. Parents and athletes are encouraged to take the Safe Sport Training provided by USA Swimming.

Seventeen PVS clubs have been the recipients of the USA Swimming Phase 1 and/or Phase 2 Grants totaling over \$81,000. In addition, PVS provided over \$190,000 of financial support during this pandemic. We hope that all PVS clubs can continue to provide service to our members.
